COMMANDER'S PROJECT: HONOR FLIGHT

The Detachment of Illinois will accept donations on behalf of all Honor Flight Network organizations serving Illinois veterans. Donation checks must state the name of the intended Honor Flight organization (ex. Honor Flight Peoria) on the memo line. Funds will be distributed directly to the designated organization

GOAL is **\$20,000** in donations by 2024 COB

⇒ **ONE FOR THE SONS**

- ◆ A membership challenge for each SAL member to recruit at least ONE new member this year to grow Detachment Membership.
- ◆ **Goal is 15,000 total membership by June 2024 Detachment COB.**
- ◆ Goal will be measured by 2024 COB Membership results. Monitored from weekly membership reports with weekly feedback provided
- ◆ **Member commitment and initiative is critical for success**
- ◆ **District and Division officers are the keys for driving results**

⇒ **BEYOND THE FOUR WALLS**

- ◆ An initiative for increased member participation in programs and activities held “beyond the four walls” of their Post at District and Division meetings, DEC, and Convention
- ◆ Attendance allows members to meet and network with others, ask questions, share ideas, learn about programs, and strengthen camaraderie.
- ◆ **GOAL – Members from at least 50% of District Squadrons in attendance at District/Division meetings**
- ◆ **GOAL – A relevant education and training session or discussion to be held at each Division and District meeting**
- ◆ **District Commanders to have personal contact (phone call or in person) (NOT only E-MAIL) with their Squadrons before key meetings as a reminder and to encourage attendance (In addition to the call letter)**
- ◆ **Measured By - Feedback/verification obtained from District Commanders**
