**CALL TO THE 61st
ANNUAL DETACHMENT CONVENTION

In compliance with Article V, Section 2, of the Detachment Constitution, the **61st ANNUAL CONVENTION** of The Sons of The American Legion, Detachment of Illinois, is called for **JULY 12 THROUGH 14, 2024 at the Wyndham Springfield Hotel, Ambassador Room, 700 East Adams Street, Springfield, Illinois.**

The purpose of this Convention is to establish Detachment policy; amend the Constitution, if necessary; elect Detachment Officers; elect Delegates and Alternates to the National Convention; and any other Detachment business that may be necessary.

REPRESENTATION: Representation in the Convention shall be by Squadrons. Each Squadron in good standing shall be entitled to one (1) Delegate and one (1) Alternate and in addition shall be entitled to one (1) Delegate and one (1) Alternate for each twenty-five (25) members or major fraction thereof, above the first twenty-five (25), as reported on the June 7, 2024 Membership Report, as required by Article V, Section 3, of the Detachment Constitution. A Squadron to be in good standing must have a minimum of ten (10) members and no indebtedness to the Detachment. Delegates-at-Large must be present at the Convention in order for their District to cast their vote. Squadrons not certified as to eligibility of 2023-2024 officers will lose their vote.

REGISTRATION: Registration will be held in the Ambassador Room. Delegates, Delegates-at-Large, Alternates and Guests may register on Friday, July 12th, from 1:30 PM to 5:00 PM; on Saturday, July 13th, from 8:00 AM to 2:00 PM; and on Sunday July 14th, from 8:00 AM and ends at 9:30 AM. Delegate forms were mailed out in May and will also be available at the registration table.

A REGISTRATION FEE OF \$10.00 PER PERSON IS REQUIRED.

Registration fee is to be paid onsite at Convention, not in advance

CONVENTION COMMITTEES: The Convention Committees will convene at 4:00 PM, Friday, July 12th, in the Ambassador Room, if necessary. Scholarship judging will also be at 4:00 PM in the Ambassador Room.

DETACHMENT EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETINGS: The Detachment Executive Committee will meet at 5:00 PM on Friday, July 12th in the Ambassador Room and again on Sunday, July 14th, immediately following the close of the National Convention Delegates & Alternates meeting in the Ambassador Room..

BUSINESS SESSIONS: The Business Sessions of the 61st Annual Detachment Convention shall convene at 11:00 AM giving everyone time to attend the Joint Memorial Service, which begins at 8:00 AM, on Saturday, July 13th; and again at 10:00 AM (**SHARP**) on Sunday, July 14th; for the remaining business and the election and installation of Officers of the Detachment of Illinois.


HOUSING: Housing forms have been mailed out and also available on Detachment and Department websites.
